#### **BEYOND BOLOGNESE**

Tucked slightly away from the well-trodden trail of red-and-white chequered tablecloths lining Lygon Street's restaurant precinct, Carlton Wine Room dishes up a modern Australian menu in a relaxed setting, while Kazuki's masters French-Japanese fusion using seasonal produce.

Continue along Lygon Street into Brunswick East (on route 1 tram) to sample the tipples on offer at urban winery Noisy Ritual, then finish up the evening exploring Old Palm Liquor's 300-strong selection of natural wines over a South Africaninspired meal straight off the grill.

#### TASTES LIKE TRADITION

Lygon Street might have expanded its menu somewhat, but Italian flavours still reign – and nowhere more than in the multi-level Mediterranean foodie playground King And Godfree.

One of Australia's first grocers has been reborn as a contemporary Italian marketplace, complete with continental deli, espresso bar, wine bar and bottle shop Agostino, and rooftop bar Johnny's Green Room. Start hungry at the bottom and then work your way up.

And because no culinary experience in Carlton is complete without artisanal Italian gelato, join the queues at Pidapipó for a scoop (or three) of classic flavours, such as fior di latte and ricotta and fig, plus seasonal specials churned fresh onsite every day.

## NEW-FASHIONED HOSPITALITY

Searching for a place to rest your weary head after a day spent eating and drinking? Look no further than Zagame's House, a boutique hotel recently revamped with a chic new interior, luxurious amenities – and
